# Why do we need a master plan?

When large sites are planned comprehensively, they bring benefits for the wider area. This is why the council included the area between Denvilles and Emsworth in its Local Plan Housing Statement and is now working on a master plan for the site, which is expected to deliver a new A27 link road, a minimum of 1,650 homes and improvements to social infrastructure. The master plan will help shape all of this.

## The master plan will establish key design elements, such as:

- A basic road layout, including a new junction on the A27
- how much and what kind of housing is needed
- shops, facilities and new school
- the size, types and location of green spaces
